Attendance for Pistol Shooters

Club Safety Rules Survey

360 members responded to the survey – it highlighted a few issues.

1. Pistols may only be used on Range 1 from 50m forward

2. Pistols may only be used on R2 from 25m forward 3. A centrefire rifle may only be shot on the LEFT HAND side of Range 2. The right hand side is only for rimfire rifles (because of the silhouettes). <u>This was the</u> <u>guestion that received the most wrong answers.</u> 4. Shotgun designated steel targets may not be shot with a pistol or rifle.

5. You may only bring 2 guests to the range with you.6. You may not move forward down range with any firearm on the bench. Even if it is unloaded and clear.7. All rifles are to be cleared and racked, pistols to be cleared, bagged or holstered.

8. Non 'B' endorsed guests may not shoot pistols greater than .22 caliber.

9. A pistol can only be transferred from its carry case to a bag or holster in a designated safety zone. Under some circumstances a pistol can be transferred from its carry case at the firing line under the direct supervision of the Range Officer.

10. Moveable bullet catchers or stops e.g. rubber filled barrels must be placed behind targets if they are not placed in front of the berm or are close to the ground.

Next year the survey will be a compulsory part of membership renewal.
